# **Heating element for HAKKO FR-801**

### ⚠ WARNING

- When replacing the heating element, be sure to unplug the power cord.
- Wait for the hanpiece to cool before working.

### How to replace the heating element

- 1. Move the tube away from the handpiece, as shown. (Figure 1)
- 2. Remove the 3 screws holding the handpiece together.
- 3. Open the handpiece. While disconnect the ground terminal and pipe from the protruding portion of the handle, remove the pipe.

#### **∴** CAUTION

Quartz glass and heat insulation are inside the pipe. Be careful not to drop or loss these items.

4. Disconnect the connector and remove the heating element. (Figure 2)


### **⚠** CAUTION


- Handle the heating element with care.
- Never rub the heating element wire!
- Insert the handle's projection into the hole in the pipe.
- 5. Insert a new heating element and reconnect the terminal.

Assemble the handle in the reverse order of disassemble.

### **∴** CAUTION

Do not tighten up the screws too much when assembling. This will damage the handpiece.
